STORYLINE: Cal State Fullerton (50-15) will take on Stanford (49-16) on Thursday at 6 p.m. CDT for a berth in the CWS championship series against Rice. Fullerton has played for a national championship four times in its history, with titles coming in 1979 (vs. Arkansas), 1984 (vs. Texas), 1995 (vs. USC) and a runner-up showing in 1992 (vs. Pepperdine). The Titans will send ace Jason Windsor (11-2, 1.81) to the mound against Stanford freshman Matt Manship (2-4, 3.44)

QUICK NOTES

▶ Fullerton is 4-1 against Stanford in 2003, but 33-40 all-time against the Cardinal...Arizona State and Wichita State are the only other programs with a winning record against the Titans (minimum 10 meetings)

▶ Other than their three-game sweep at UC Riverside, the Titans have not lost consecutive games all season

▶ Jason Windsor is 3-0 with a 1.42 ERA in the postseason and opponents are batting .159...he has not allowed more than one earned run in his last five starts

▶ Windsor has the 13th-best ERA in the country entering the CWS

▶ Windsor allowed a run on three hits in 2.0 innings against Stanford on Feb. 1

▶ Fullerton's pitching staff has allowed more than five runs in a game just twice in the last 18 games

▶ Fullerton is 11-3 against Pac-10 teams this season (4-1 vs. Stanford, 3-0 vs. UCLA, 2-1 vs. ASU, 2-1 vs. USC)

▶ Fullerton has won 50 games for the seventh time in 29 Division I seasons and just the third time in the last 19 years

▶ Nearly half (5 of 11) of Justin Turner's extra-base hits have come in postseason play

▶ The Titans have homered in five consecutive games for the first time this season

▶ In their last five games, the Titans have held conference players of the year to just one hit in 23 at bats (co-Pac-10 Player of the Year Dustin Pedroia of ASU was 0-for-13 in the super regional, SEC Player of the Year Aaron Hill of LSU was 0-for-4 in the CWS opener and co-Pac-10 Player of the Year Ryan Garko of Stanford is 1-for-6)

▶ Kurt Suzuki has set CWS records for most HBP in a game (three vs. LSU in the opener) and in a series (four)

▶ The Titans have blown a two-run lead just once this season (vs. Long Beach State on Mar. 28) and have never lost when they've built a lead of three runs or more

▶ The Titan pitching staff has posted a 7-2 record and 2.85 ERA in the postseason while allowing opponents just a .224 batting average

▶ Opponents are batting just .213 in the College World Series

▶ Fullerton is 15-4 against ranked teams in 2003

▶ The Titans have scored nearly two-thirds of their postseason runs (32 of 50) in the first three innings

▶ Fullerton has allowed just one stolen base in seven postseason games and has stolen 13 bases

▶ Chad Cordero has a career postseason ERA of 1.16 (23.1 innings in 13 appearances)

Overall, he has allowed just one run in his last 35.1 innings (0.25 ERA), a stretch of 25 appearances dating back to March 19.

▶ Fullerton has gone 20 consecutive games without scoring in double figures, its longest such stretch since 1983 (24 games)

▶ Overall, the Titans have scored in double figures 22 times this season while opponents have done it only once (UC Riverside scored 13 runs on May 2)

▶ The Titans have not been shut out this season

▶ Fullerton has won 11 of its last 14 games, with nine of those wins coming against ranked teams
