### » PAM EDDE (1981)

Edde was masterful for the Titans from the circle, posting a 25-8 record and a 0.61 ERA. She also hit .284 that season with 34 runs scored, six doubles, 15 RBI and 32 walks.

### » SUE LEWIS (1981, 1982 & 1984)

One of two three-time All-American Titans, Lewis hit .354 with 25 home runs and 138 RBI in her career. Lewis still holds school career records for hits (257), doubles (53), and triples (20).

### » JANET LLOYD (1981)

Another "Titan"-ic slugger for Fullerton, Lloyd hit .381 with 15 home runs and 41 RBI in her All-American season. Her home run mark stands third on the single-season list.

### » KATHY VAN WYK (1982)

After transferring from Texas Women's University, Van Wyk posted a 35-1 record with a 0.18 ERA and 270 strikeouts. She was named the National Player of the Year, winning Fullerton's first-ever Honda Broderick Award.

### » ELISE KING (1983)

King hit .293 with 35 runs and 16 RBI while stealing 12 bases for the Titans in her All-American year.

### » SUSAN LEFEBVRE (1983 & 1986)

LeFebvre finished her career with a 100-21 record in the circle and a 0.29 ERA to go with 740 strikeouts. In 1986, she became the second Titan to be named Player of the Year and helped Fullerton to the National Championship.

### » DEBBIE MYGIND (1985)

Posted a 28-4 record with a 0.27 ERA and 183 strikeouts. She is second in career ERA and third in career winning percentage.

### » JOANN FERRIERI (1985)

Hit .328 with 27 runs and 23 RBI, leading the team in hitting.

### » TERRI OBERG (1985)

The third Titan All-American in 1985, Oberg hit .298 with 7 home runs and 35 RBI – both team high's. Her eight triples that season set a school record.

### » CHENITA ROGERS (1986 & 1987)

A career .365 hitter who led the team in hitting in both of her All-American seasons. Hit .386 in 1986 to help the Titans to the national title.

### » CONNIE CLARK (1987)

The current Texas head coach went 33-5 with a 0.47 ERA and 261 strikeouts en route to Co-Big West Player of the Year and Fullerton's third Broderick Award.

### » VALERIE DOUGLAS (1988)

Led the team with a .351 average with 19 runs and 28 RBI. Her 72 hits rank tied for ninth on the single-season charts.

### » MISSY COOMBES (1989)

Hit .359 with 14 doubles and 29 RBI. Went on to earn three All-Big West and two All-West Region honors.

### » CAREY HESS (1989)

Hit .409 with 10 doubles and 52 runs, which stood as a school record until 2001.

### » JOY TINER (1990)

Hit .311 with 30 runs and 17 RBI. Was a two-time All-Big West selection.

### » ANN VAN DORTRECHT (1990)

Was 29-12 with a 0.43 ERA while pitching a school season record of 310.2 innings. Was named Big West Pitcher of the Year in 1990.

### » TIFFANY BOYD (1991 & 1992)

Combined 63-15 in her two All-America seasons with 543 strikeouts. A three-time Big West Pitcher of the Year.

### » PAULA "MICH" DEBREE (1991)

Hit .313 with nine doubles, 33 runs and 19 RBI. A two-time All-Big West honoree.

### » DENISE DEWALT (1992 & 1993)

DeWalt hit .396 for her career, a record which stood until 2003, to go with 70 runs, 29 doubles and 49 RBI.

### » CHRIS ZBORIL (1995)

Led the team with a .373 average, eight home runs and 25 RBI.

### » STEPHENIE LITTLE (1999)

Led the team with a .372 average, 57 RBI, and set the single-season record with 23 home runs.

### » MONICA LUCATERO (2000)

Hit .343 with six home runs and 39 RBI while walking a team-high 20 times. Named top the All-Big West second team.

### » JENNY TOPPING (2001, 2002 & 2003)

The Titans' second three-time All-American (all first-team honors), Topping holds four career records and seven single-season marks.

### » YASMIN MOSSADEGHI (2002)

Named to the third team after hitting .367 with 13 home runs and 45 RBI. Was also an All-Big West and All-West Region first team selection while being invited to U.S. National Team Camp.

### » GINA OAKS (2002 & 2003)

Twice earned All-America honors as a utility player (Oaks pitched, played second and third base, and the outfield), hitting .295 for her career and 74-23 with a 1.37 ERA in the circle.

### » JODIE COX (2003)

An All-American pitcher in 2003, Cox was 21-7 in the circle with a 1.06 ERA and 224 strikeouts. She went undefeated in conference play in her final two seasons (21-0).

### » JULIE WATSON (2004)

Completing one of the biggest offensive turn-arounds in Titan softball history, Watson was named to the second team after hitting .426 and amassing 78 hits – both of which rank among the school's top 10 for a single season.
